

[from p1] It is really important that those providing the care are open and honest with both the patient and relatives. Being better informed can reduce stress and anxiety and help people understand what to expect. Healthwatch Shropshire would like to know whether the language used by those giving the care was appropriate and did it prepare people for what was to happen? Were other ways of communicating found if the person's preferences couldn't be expressed verbally. either because of dementia or brain injury, for example?

Lynn Cawley, Chief Officer of Healthwatch Shropshire, said: "We are keen to build up a picture of how well End of Life Care is working across Shropshire and whether people feel that they received the right support for them. We want to find out whether care for the dying is equitable across the county and if there is a joined up approach between different services to End of Life Care including out of hours services.
