Events coming soon

Village Hall repairs and refurbishment

The Village Hall has suffered from subsidence which has caused cracks in the walls, particularly in the kitchen and the toilets. Repairs have been agreed with our insurers and should start soon – we will try to ensure as little disruption as possible to normal Hall use. We are also planning significant refurbishments to the Hall, including a wheelchair-friendly entrance and lobby, a new floor and internal and external redecoration. This will require grant funding and we would welcome your comments on our plans when they are more advanced – we hope to hold an open exhibition of the proposals for you to view. Meanwhile we would be very grateful for any help you can offer – we particularly need advice and expertise in relation to flooring options and building regulations. Caynham Parochial Church Council wish to notify everyone of a change in services.

Commencing February 2015 Caynham St Mary's church will hold two services per month. The 1st Sunday will be an "All Age" worship with Holy Communion, and the 3rd Sunday would be Matins.
