Village Hall refurbishment update

The grant from Ludlow Rotary Cares has been used to purchase insulated curtains for the Hall; curtain poles were funded by a separate private donation. The curtains should be fitted in early February.

We've received the grant of £1,000 from the Tesco Bags of Help scheme. This will be used to replace the old kitchen windows, to upgrade the heating in the male and female toilets and to replace one heater in the main hall. The heating upgrade should also happen at the beginning of February. We hope to be able to source the remaining heaters soon – the cost is under £300.
