#### Open House event

There was a clear favourite amongst the options for a refurbished Village Hall presented at the recent Open House event. The preferred layout is shown as a floor plan and a 3D view at the right. The design features:

- Removal of the stage
- A new wide entrance in the west gable end
- An access ramp for wheelchairs and prams
- An entrance lobby
- A dedicated bar area
- Replace or repaired steps to current entrance
- Underfloor insulation in the main hall
- New flooring in the main hall
- Replacement windows in the extension
- Hand dryers and extractor fans in the toilets
- New heaters with improved controls
