VILLAGE HALL REFURBISHMENT

Thanks to Caynham Parish Council we've now raised sufficient funds to complete all the planned refurbishment work and a few extras too. The Council responded to our request for extra heaters (mentioned in the last newsletter) with a very generous donation of £2,500. In conjunction with the Tesco Bags of Help grant, this will allow us to replace all the windows at the rear of the Hall, install a completely new heating system, upgrade the lighting and provide extractor fans in the toilets. We will also have a trolley to move chairs around, saving the backs of those who set up and clear up before and after events. We are very grateful for this support, which will bring our refurbishment project to an end: it started in 2015 and has raised a total of £23,500, of which £2,000 came from the Hall's reserves and almost £800 from local donations. The other donors were Awards for All England, Wesley's, the Garfield Weston Foundation, Severn Trent Water and Ludlow Rotary Cares and our thanks go to all of them.

Using the Village Hall and its facilities


