## 'Antarctica' – talk by Caynham's Dr Neil Spencer

An audience of over 50 enjoyed an informative and entertaining presentation by Neil about his experience with the British Antarctic Survey, illustrated by his own superb photographs. From October 2016, Neil was resident doctor at Haley base, built on the ice shelf. Periodically the base has to be moved – this was Haley VI – and two years ago plans were made to relocate because a crack had developed in the ice shelf. This threatened to create a very large iceberg with Haley VI on it! Neil described the massive task of moving the living and working quarters to the new base. The move was successful, but another crack in the ice shelf was detected and computer modelling suggested this could eventually pass right through the new site. If this happened in the Antarctic winter (3 or 4 months of total darkness) it would be almost impossible to get the staff out - the sea ice extends too far for ships to approach and flying is extremely hazardous. The site had to be evacuated before the winter, so Neil returned to the UK much earlier than expected. Undeterred, he hopes to back in Antarctica again in (our) autumn. Many thanks to Neil for a great evening, and to those who provided tea, coffee and cakes. Thanks also to those who supported the event which raised over £300 for the Village Hall.
