### Please read this - it concerns everyone in Caynham

Many people avoid AGMs because they're seen as bureaucratic and boring. This year, the AGM for Caynham Village Hall is different because there is a real possibility that the Hall will be unable to continue operating normally unless it receives more local support. Ironically, this situation has been reached when the Hall's finances are far better than they have ever been. This provides us with a cushion that gives time for the Hall's operations to be rejuvenated.

Now the Hall has reopened it is clear that the existing committee of four cannot continue in its present form: I am again on chemotherapy and can no longer perform the role of Chairman – and since my condition is incurable this situation will not improve; Jean is shielding, as my carer; Caroline has been on the committee since 2005 and understandably would like to retire; Barbara is the Parish Council representative (the only person eligible for this).

The existing committee members are prepared to continue for the present in order to allow new arrangements to be put in place, but this must be seen as an interim stop-gap. I will continue to handle the finances and background admin and to publish the newsletter as long as my health allows. Jean and I will also continue as Committee members for the time being. The Committee will honour existing social bookings and continue with our regular hirers.
