WW2 on Our Doorsteps?

A planning application ([22/03770/FUL](https://www.planning.southern.gov.uk/22/03770/FUL)) has been submitted to change the use of good agricultural land to sports and leisure. The intention is to allow up to 100 people to regularly re-enact WW2 battles to the detriment of local residents, wildlife, Shropshire landscape, local amenity and agriculture (see: www.frontlineevent.co.uk/h-hour). The applicants want to construct a fake village with a "Slutty Nun" Inn, tank, cafe, church, bistro and well surrounded by buildings and houses, dispersed farms, a C47 crash site, gun battery and shallow trench networks. In their own words "copious amounts of covering, or suppressing fire, and smoke will be required to win this type of terrain!".

Is this appropriate in an area so close to historic Ludlow and the Shropshire Hills AONB?

Healthy Start Voucher Scheme

Healthy start is an NHS Scheme that supports families on low income to buy fruit, vegetables and milk and access free vitamins. In Shropshire, uptake of the NHS Healthy Start Voucher Scheme has fallen below 30%. Many Shropshire families are struggling with the cost-of-living crisis. It has never

been more important for the most vulnerable families to access the financial support available to them. Shropshire Council wants to encourage eligible families to apply for Healthy Start. Public Health has been working with partners including Shropshire Food Poverty Alliance and the Trussell Trust to improve awareness and uptake of the NHS Healthy Start Scheme. All professionals working with pregnant people and young families can play a key role by talking about Healthy Start and promoting the offer. The scheme is now digital, making the application process easier.
